Presidents Report – October 4, 2017 Annual General Meeting

We have increased our membership by 18 since the beginning of 2017 which brings our total to 97. As you may be aware, NAOSH week is celebrated every year in Canada, The United States and Mexico and is kicked off in each country with a National Launch. I am proud to announce that the New Brunswick Chapter has been chosen to host the Canadian National Launch of NAOSH week for 2019 in Saint John. This is a great opportunity to showcase our great province and prove you do not have to be a big chapter to achieve big things.

Keeping with NAOSH, if you attended the recent Professional Development Conference in Halifax you would have heard that for the 2018 National Launch they are circulating a NAOSH Jersey to all of the Chapters in the country where members of the executive will sign it and it will be presented to the host committee in Vancouver next May. The Jersey is due in New Brunswick next week where a few of us will sign in, post to social media and then send it off to the next chapter.

To encourage attendance at meetings this year we offered a ballot for each meeting attended that went toward the conference fee for the CSSE PDC conference in 2017 or 2018 or for the course fee for an upcoming CHSC course. CRSP Update - October 4, 2017 Annual General Meeting

As you may be aware the Board of Canadian Registered Safety Professionals is making some changes that we wanted to pass along to you.

First they are introducing a new designation called the CRST or Canadian registered Safety Technician and expects to start applications in late 2018. Please follow this link which will take you to the BCRSP website for further information http://bcrsp.ca/newsroom/bcrsp-developing-canadian-registered-safety-technician-crst-certification

Second, there will be new eligibility guidelines in place starting in July of 2018 to obtain your CRSP designation. One of the changes is in the education requirements which will be applied to all existing CRSP certificate holders as well. It is my understanding that if after the change in 2018 you do not meet the new education requirements you will have to meet them or the Board will be offering on line courses that will act as the equivalent to bring you up to the new requirements. These courses have not been developed yet but in conversations with some people involved the current thinking is there will be up to 4 courses which will be 3 to 4 hours in duration and the intent is they will be offered with little or no cost to the certificate holder.

I urge those of you that are considering this designation to prepare to challenge the CRSP exam in May of 2018 prior to the changes taking place. To do this you should have your application submitted by December of this year. If you have your designation and are not sure about education requirements then I suggest you keep checking the BCRSP website for updates.

This information is not sanctioned by the BCRSP and has been gained through conversations with folks who are involved in the process and is provided as an update to members of the New Brunswick Chapter of the CSSE.
